

THE ORIGINAL FARMERS MARKET CODE OF CONDUCT

The Original Farmers Market is private property and has not at any time been dedicated to public uses. While visiting the Farmers Market, you are asked to refrain from the following activities:

1. Possessing any item that would be used as a weapon, including, but not limited to: firearms, explosives, fireworks, clubs or sticks over ¼ inch in diameter, chemical dispensing devices, knives with blades over 2 inches in length, or any other object(s) that may be used in any way to inflict bodily injury on another person.
2. Any unlawful act, behavior, or activity.
3. Any smoking of tobacco, vape or e-cigarette products other than in designated smoking areas.
4. Any smoking or ingestion of marijuana or other illicit drug on the property.
5. Any activity not consistent with the general purpose of the property, which is shopping, dining, or visiting offices for business.
6. Solicitation of donations or distributing material/food items of any kind except with prior written agreement by Farmers Market management.
7. Running, yelling, horseplay, disorderly conduct, or the unsafe use of common areas. Sitting on floors, handrails, stairs, trash receptacles, planters and other areas not specifically intended for seating.
8. No riding manual or motorized skateboards, roller-skates, rollerblades, bicycles, scooters, or gyro-scooters, which obstruct or interfere with the free flow of pedestrian traffic or with visitors' view of windows and displays.
9. Intimidating or harassing persons on the property, any verbal threat to any person, or any attempt to use physical force or fighting.
10. Any loitering.
11. Any use of inciteful language that include, but not limited to, sexually explicit language, obscene gestures or racial, religious, or ethnic slurs that upset or disturb the peace of others.
12. Failing to be fully clothed or wearing apparel that, based upon notice given by the Original Farmers Market personnel, creates discomfort or fear in others.
13. Offensive personal hygiene or inappropriate grooming or bathing on the property.

14. Bringing animals other than dogs inside the Original Farmers Market, except service animals. All animals must be leashed. No animals are permitted on 2nd floor dining decks or in the Community Room, except service animals. No animals are permitted to be on any tables or chairs.

15. Playing audible radios, musical instruments, or other devices.

16. Consumption of outside alcoholic beverages, or consuming alcoholic beverages outside of specifically designated areas.

17. Consumption of outside food that was not purchased in the Original Farmers Market. 18. Rummaging through or removing items from trash receptacles, dining tables or service areas.

19. Sleeping on the property.

20. Engaging in accordance with non-commercial its rules expressive activities and gathering signatures without prior written permission of Management in for such activities.

21. Photographing or videotaping in and around the interior or exterior of the Original Farmers Market for commercial purposes, including social media, without prior written permission of Management.

22. Using drones or other controlled flying device(s) anywhere in Farmers Market without Management's express written permission.

The Original Farmers Market is not responsible for any lost or stolen items, or any damaged personal property. Visit the Farmers Market Office for information on found items.

It is unlawful for any minor under the age of eighteen (18) years old to be present in an unsupervised place between the hours of 10:00pm on any day and sunrise the following day. (45.03(a) LAMC Nighttime Curfew)

Visitors who do not act responsibly or adhere to this Code of Conduct may be asked to leave and/or be restricted from returning to property for a specified amount of time. If they refuse to leave property, they may be arrested and prosecuted for criminal trespass. Update 11/1/2022
